ORGANIZATIONAL HISTORY

Robinson's Flowers was operated by Novice C. Robinson (1891-1984) at 912 State Street; city directories indicate an earlier location for the shop at 432 East Main Street. Besides producing floral arrangements for individuals and special events, the shop also sold bulbs, a limited supply of bedding plants, shrubbery, and some gift items. The exact date of the demise of the business is not known. Robinson, who later worked for Deemer Floral Company and was very active in local and regional garden clubs, died March 11, 1984 and is buried in Fairview Cemetery.

COLLECTION NOTE

This small collection includes an account book (472 pages) for the florist operation from 1924 to 1929. Entries are dated, include a description of the arrangement made or merchandise purchased, the cost, and where it was sent. A shop invoice from 1925 is included as well as an inventory of various items available in the shop.
