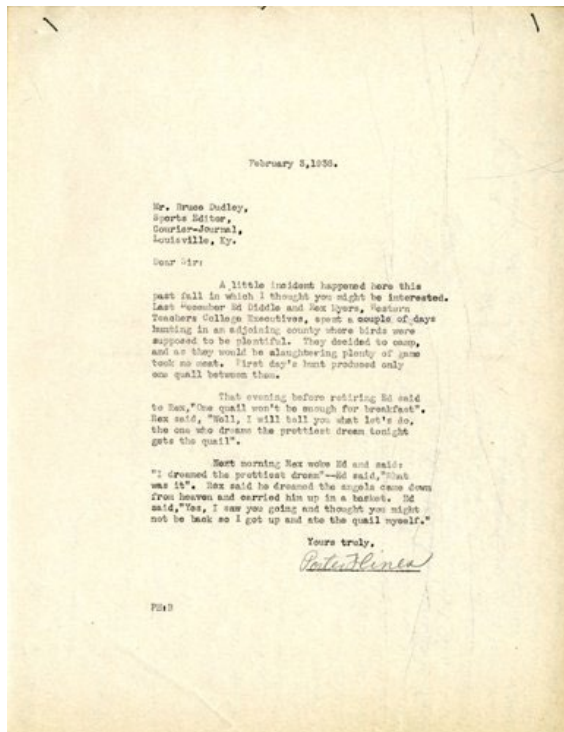

Title Letter to Bruce Dudley

Description Letter from Porter Hines to Bruce Dudley, sports editor of the Louisville Courier Journal relating the following story regarding E.A. Diddle:

A little incident happened here this past fall in which I thought you might be interested.
