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#### How to use the KEY TO DATES OF ACTS :

To the left of each entry there is a volume and page number. Turn back to the Key to Dates of Acts and find the volume number and page number and to the left will be found the date and session.

For example: Dooley, Moses lists Vol 3 Page 103. Turning back to the key we find that Vol 3 page 103 would be found in the 1803 November Session of Kentucky Acts .since 1803 November Session covers pages 101-165 which would include page 103.
