


BILL MOORE INSURANCE VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT

1019 STATE STREET CA. 1870

The Volunteer Fire Department Building, 1019 State Street, owned by Bill Moore was completed earlier this month. This building has undergone extensive rehabilitation work on the facade and both first and second floor interiors.

The first floor is occupied by the owner's business, Bill Moore Insurance, Inc. and the second floor by Reporting Unlimited, a court reporting business.

The project contractor was Stewart-Richey Construction Company.

Another project recently completed in the Downtown Historic District was the McIntire Building located at 1025 State Street and owned by Joe Bill Campbell.

This formerly vacant structure was finished this summer with complete facade work and adaptive reuse of first and second floors for the law offices of Campbell, Smith, and Kerrick.


The contractor for the project was Kermit Tabor.


