Record of Proceedings of Board of Regents of Western State Normal School, Bowling Green, Ky.

Minutes of Joint Meeting of Regents of the Kentucky State Normal School, held at Frankfort, June 2<sup>nd</sup>, 1906.

The Board of Regents appointed by the Governor for the Eastern and Western State Normal Schools of Kentucky, met in joint session on June 2<sup>nd</sup>, 1906, at eleven o'clock A.M. in the office of the State Superintendent of Public Instruction, Hon. Jas. H. Fuqua, presiding.

J.W. Cammock was chosen temporary secretary.

The following members were present: Eastern District – P. W. Ginstead, J. A. Sullivan, J. W. Cammock and Fred A. Vaughn. Western District – E. H. Mark, J. Whitt Potter, H. C. Miller and H. K. Cole. The oath of office was administered to each member by hon. Jas. H. Fuqua.

The question of salary of Secretary of each Board came up and was fixed at \$200. per annum.

- H. C. Miller was chosen Secretery for the Western Board and Fred A. Vaughn Secretary of the Eastern Board.
- H.K. Cole was chosen Vice-President of the Western Board and P. W. Grinstead Vice-President of the Eastern Board.

The question of salary for Treasurer of each Board came up and upon motion was fixed at \$50.00 per annum and in addition thereto, expenses of filing bond was to be borne by each Board out of appropriation for respective schools.

Minutes of Meeting held June 2<sup>nd</sup>, (continued).

Mr. G. D. Sledge, of Bowling Green, was elected Treasurer of the Western Board and Mr. R. E. Turley of Richmond, was elected Treasurer of the Eastern Board.

The salary of the President of each school was fixed at \$3,000.00 per annum.

Motion carried, directing each school to be opened for work some time during the month of September, 1906.

Motion carried, naming Hon. J. H. Fuqua, Sr. and the Presidents of the two schools as Committee to arrange salaries of subordinate teachers and report.

The following resolution was adopted: Resolved – That the President of each school shall nominate the members of the faculty for the school of which he is President, subject to the approval of the Board of Regents of that school for which they are nominated.

The joint meeting then adjourned.
