

Upon motion of Regent Haswell, which was duly seconded and passed, President H. H. Cherry was re-elected for a term of two years and the teachers for the scholastic year beginning on September 9th and other employees for the fiscal year at salaries indicated below. This to date from July 1, 1919.

Motion made by Regent Cooper, seconded by Regent Dean and passed that the barracks receive one coat of filling and at least one coat of paint. The local Regent, Mr. J. W. Potter, and Mr. Byrn were appointed to look after the matter.

Regent Haswell moved that the walls of the Administration Building be painted and be given a cement coat, the local Regent and Mr. Byrn to attend to the matter. Seconded by Mr. Cooper and passed.

The Board then invited Dr. Kinnaman to appear before them and make any reports or suggestions he might desire. He made a short general statement relative to the welfare of the school.
