

Proposal from the Professional Responsibilities
and Concerns Committee (PRC:002.1)

The PRC Committee will provide a forum for any faculty member with a written grievance who has exhausted the normal channels for resolving grievances—the Department Head, the Dean of the College, the Vice President for Academic Affairs, and the President of the University.

The PRC Committee will notify the Department Head, College Dean, Academic Vice-President, and President three weeks in advance of the meeting date that the faculty grievance will be reviewed. The administrators will be invited to provide written documentation supporting their positions prior to the meeting date and will be invited to appear before the Committee if they desire.

After reviewing the grievance, the PRC Committee will form an opinion and report the opinion to the Faculty Senate.

The PRC Committee will not be concerned with grievances concerning non-tenure, non-promotion, sex discrimination, or any other issues for which the University has existing review procedures and committees.
