### **BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE**

George Vernon Page was born on 26 July 1890 in Graves County, Kentucky. He attended Western Kentucky State Normal School from 1909 to 1914, but received his bachelors degree from the University of Kentucky in 1917. He matriculated at the University of Illinois in 1923 and received his Master's degree from that institution in 1926. He became head of the Physics Department at Western Kentucky University in 1920 and retired in 1960. He died on 5 March 1985 in Bowling Green, Kentucky and was buried in Fairview Cemetery.

Page was married to Anna Reid Jones Page and was a member of the First Christian Church, Bowling Green, Kentucky.

### **COLLECTION NOTES**

This collection is almost exclusively letters written by service men in World War II and the Korean War to their former physics professor, Dr. George Vernon Page, at Western Kentucky State Teachers College (now Western Kentucky University). They are arranged in individual folders by the name of the correspondent and then arranged chronologically within the folder. The original V-Mails from folders 2-10 are located in folder 12.
