**Administrative History:** A manual arts program was first listed in the 1911 catalog. It reappears in the 1920 catalog under the direction of L.T. Smith. By 1928 the department had become Industrial Education. In 1957 Smith was named director of the Physical Plant. Walter Nalbach was named head of Industrial Arts.
