***BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE***

Albert Ray Douglas was born 17 June 1916 in Bowling Green, Kentucky, the son of Albert Leon "Doc" Douglas (1889-1960) and Mary Alice (Ray) Douglas (1892-1982). He married Grace E. Fields, born 19 February 1917. Albert and Grace attended Bowling Green High School (BGHS) and graduated in 1934 and 1935 respectively. He worked as a pharmacist in Bowling Green; they were members of First Baptist Church.

***COLLECTION NOTE***

This collection consists of one-half box of material relating chiefly to reunions of Bowling Green High School's classes of 1934 and 1935. Included are clippings, programs, directories, and correspondence related to these classes and their reunions. Of special interest is a folder of letters sent to Grace Douglas from alumni of the BGHS class of 1935 concerning the class's 50<sup>th</sup> reunion in 1985. Also included is an autograph album kept by Mr. Douglas in 1928.
