BIOGRAPHY

John Henry Clagett was born 7 April 1916 in Bowling Green, Kentucky, the son of William Argo and Sena (Ballard) Clagett. He graduated from College High on the campus of Western Kentucky State College then attended Western Kentucky State College for three years before entering the United States Naval Academy in 1936. He graduated from the Academy in 1940 and went immediately into active duty. In 1943 he was badly burned when the PT boat he was commanding was sunk by a Japanese ship off Guadalcanal. He retired from the Navy in 1946.

He served several years with the U.S. embassy in Oslo, Norway, before returning to the United States to pursue graduate studies at Yale University. He received his PhD in 1954 and taught creative writing at Middlebury College in Vermont. He married Marjorie R. Douglas and had two daughters, Marjorie and Randi Ann.

In addition to his first novel, *Cradle of the Sun*, he authored numerous other novels including *Papa Tango*, *Captain Whitecap*, *The Slot*, and *Buckskin Cavalier*. His short stories appeared in magazines such as *Saturday Evening Post*, *Colliers*, and *Blue Book*. Clagett's naval background and experiences are evident in many of his writings.

COLLECTION

This collection consists of a typed manuscript of Clagett's first novel, *Cradle of the Sun*, a photo of Clagett and his fiancé, Marjorie Douglas, two short stories by Clagett and newspaper clippings about Clagett.
