This collection consists of materials compiled by John Alan Dowell for a project on George Morris Carter, a storyteller from Monroe County, Kentucky. Content consists chiefly of biographical data and stories exhibiting Carter's storytelling talent. Materials include interviews done by Dowell with Carter; a complete transcript of one Carter interview, cassette tapes of the interviews, tape summaries for the other interviews and a partial transcription for one. The collection also contains a glossary, bibliography, and photos relating to the interviews with Carver. This project was completed as a requirement for a folk studies class at Western Kentucky University in 1983.
