Minutes of the Student Government Association February 10, 1999

Call to Order: Vice President Chad Lewis called the regular meeting of the Student Government Association to order at 5:04pm in the Congressional Chambers of the Downing University Center.

Roll Call: Vice President of Administration Matt Bastin called roll. Minutes: It was moved and seconded to suspend with the reading of the minutes. Motion approved.

Officer Reports: President, Stephanie Cosby – The President asked Congress to keep up the good work and encouraged Congress to write more legislation. Stephanie reminded Congress about the game tomorrow night against UALR. There will be a Rules Committee Meeting for Academic Affairs Council on Feb. 11th @ 3:00pm in WAB. Stephanie thanked Student Affairs for doing a great job with the camp fair.

Executive Vice President, Chad Lewis – Chad reported that Provide-A-Ride use for last week was only seventeen down almost one hundred from the previous week. Mr. Lewis also reported that the previous account balance stood at 23,074.84. Expenditures for the week totaled \$1,133.17, which leaves the account balance at \$21,941.67.

Author Kyle Matthews spoke in favor of the resolution. Adam Howard made a motion to accept and it was seconded. Motion approved.


New Business: Resolution 99-1-S *Placing Emergency Telephones in South Campus Parking Lots* was read for
