#### **COLLECTION NOTES**

Collection consists of interviews conducted by Teresa D. Klimowicz with Esther (Magers) Isbell, Bowling Green, Kentucky. The focus of the interviews is on Esther's work as a folk artist, and particularly on her biblical quilts. She discusses patterns, techniques, materials and the function of quilts in her life. Isbell also discusses her extensive sewing career and the personal satisfaction gained from the process. Also included is a detailed discussion of Esther's life, such as her childhood on a farm in Barren County, Kentucky, her many occupations, including running her own boardinghouses, community involvement, views on marriage, love, family, education, and religious life. This project was completed as a requirement for a folk studies class at Western Kentucky University in1983.
