COLLECTION NOTE

This collection consists of interviews conducted by Ann Celine Taft with Zéléme (Brashear) Cottrell, Bowling Green, Kentucky, about her weaving. Cottrell discusses the weaving process in depth, including discussions of materials, drafts, patterns, weaves, looms, the best time and mood for weaving, local and community weaving clubs, and weaving as a therapeutic art. Cottrell also discusses her life and family, and their many moves before returning to Bowling Green after World War II. Also, Cottrell briefly discusses selling her patterns to *America Homes* magazine. This project was completed as a requirement for a folk studies class at Western Kentucky University in 1983.
