# ORGANIZATIONAL HISTORY

The Warren County Historical Society was organized 15 June 1962. Dr. Joseph Young was elected the group's first president. When the Society was incorporated in 1966, the stated purposes were "to collect and preserve historical materials relating to the general sciences, history, literature and art, especially of Warren County, Kentucky; to encourage and foster historical research and the study of the culture of this region, including its pioneer life, and to publish its findings; protection of historic sites and the erection of markers; to acquire land and buildings having historical significance and the maintenance and development thereof." In the late 1980s, the Society went through a period of inactivity. It was reactivated briefly in 1990-1992 but soon went inactive. The organization disbanded in the mid-1990s.

## **COLLECTION NOTE**

This collection consists chiefly of business papers, minutes, correspondence, membership lists, copies of historic documents, miscellaneous newspaper clippings, and yearbooks of the Warren County Historical Society from 1962 to 1988. Also included are papers presented at Society meetings and student papers written as part of the Society's essay contest on such topics as education and religion in Warren County, the Civil War in Warren County, and prominent figures in the history of the county.
