Bill 06-05-F Transfer Student Forum Refreshments

There was a motion to have this piece of legislation constructively read. Motion was seconded and approved. Lindsey Lilly was recognized as the author, explaining that this piece of legislation is self-explanatory. During debate, Lindsey Lilly made the following amendments; it should say Second Reading November 15, 2005; in the PURPOSE clause, the word "of" should be taken out and it should read "...all allocation up to \$240.00..."; the second WHEREAS clause should read "To provide said refreshments would cost up to \$240.00"; and in the THEREFORE clause it should read "...will hereby allocate \$240.00 for..." Previous question was called and seconded. Previous question passed unanimously. Legislation passed unanimously.
