#### **COLLECTION NOTES**

Collection consists of a project titled *The Life of Dr. C.C. Howard*, oral history interviews conducted by Betsy Tyrie about Carl Clifford Howard, the outstanding Glasgow, Kentucky, physician who was instrumental in the fight against tuberculosis. He also founded several medical facilities in Glasgow and initiated the Kentucky Medical Association Rural Scholarship Fund. Includes interviews conducted between 1983-1984, with those who knew Dr. Howard, including Governor A. B. "Happy" Chandler, family, friends, and colleagues. Each interview has a tape summary included in the collection. Archive material also includes an autobiographical interview with Dr. Howard recorded in 1964 for his grandchildren and a speech given at the Barren County Historical Society in 1969. Project contains supplementary newspaper clippings about Howard and his wife, Julia Franklin Howard. This project was completed as a requirement for a folk studies class at Western Kentucky University in 1984.
