ORGANIZATIONAL HISTORY

In 1813 Union Church was established by Elder Leonard Page and others who had come to the Russellville, Logan County, Kentucky area from Goochland County, Virginia in 1811. Page was a Revolutionary War veteran who served as the church's first pastor for 18 years. In 1818, 10 members from the Union church were granted letters to start a Baptist church in Russellville with Page also serving as pastor there. This congregation became the First Baptist Church of Russellville. The original log meeting house of Union Church was constructed on the Clarksville Road, near Dry Fork. A new brick building was built in August 1859 on the Hopkinsville Road and the church has been known as New Union since then.

COLLECTION NOTE

This collection consists of photocopies of the minutes and membership records of New Union Baptist Church, Logan County, Kentucky from 3 February 1872 to 7 June 1987. Also included are minutes of the Ladies Missionary and Aid Society from November 1889 to 8 October 1913.
