BIOGRAPHY

William Montgomery Temple was born on 28 September 1893 in Bowling Green, Kentucky, to Robert Willis Temple and Loudella (Perry) Temple. William lived elsewhere the majority of his life. He was a resident of Washington, D.C., for many years, but retained his love for his hometown and its history. Temple was also an autograph collector, specializing in this acquisition of Kentucky governors' autographs. William died on 26 October 1967 in Howard County, Maryland.

THE COLLECTION

The collection consists chiefly of autograph letters, especially those of Kentucky governors covering the period from 1805 to 1951 (50 items); other manuscript documents, which were collected for their autographical value, dating from 1715 to 1941 (16 items); and Temple's articles and notes about Bowling Green, centering on the post office and fire department during the years of 1901 to 1964 (14 items).
