MINUTES

Meeting
of the
Council of Academic Deans
October 4, 1988

Dr. Robert V. Haynes called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Members present included Drs. Ward Hellstrom, Elmer Gray, J. Michael Brown, John H. Petersen and Ronnie N. Sutton. Dr. Carl Martray represented Dr. J. T. Sandefur, Dr. Martin Houston represented Dr. Charles Kupchella, and Mr. Laswell represented Dr. Michael Binder.

Dr. Haynes made several announcements. The next Board of Regents meeting is scheduled for October 27, 1988, at 3:30 p.m. The dedication of the L.D. Brown Ag Expo Center will be held on October 29. He also reported on plans which have been initiated for the observation of the bicentennial of Kentucky's founding as a state.

The proposed policy on cooperative education/internship experiences was discussed. The deans agreed to support the part of the policy which relates to the requirement that students enroll for credit concurrently with the coop/internship experience. The issue of faculty load credit will be deferred until the matter is discussed with the department heads and Ms. Carol White.

There was extensive discussion of procedures for implementing community college programs during a transition period in the establishment of a separate community college. Dr. Haynes agreed to revise the proposed procedures in view of some of the concerns expressed.


Salary policy was then discussed. The issue of the role of merit evaluations was considered again and will be discussed further.

Part-time faculty policies were discussed. The proposed Certification of Qualifications form and Terms of Employment and Assignment form were approved by the deans. These forms will be distributed to department heads at a meeting in the near future. Dr. Petersen discussed data on part-time faculty employment trends at Western which were distributed to the deans. There has been a significant increase in the use of part-time faculty over the last three years. The deans were also provided information on projected expenditures for on-campus part-time faculty for the 1988-89 academic year.

Dr. Gray distributed information on the status and characteristics of currently enrolled graduate students at Western.

The meeting was adjourned at 12:30 p.m.
