MINUTES

May 23, 1989

Dr. Robert V. Haynes called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Members present included Drs. Elmer Gray, Ward Hellstrom, J. Michael Brown, Ronnie N. Sutton and John H. Petersen. Dr. Stephen B. Schnacke represented Dr. J. T. Sandefur, Mr. Lynn Greeley represented Dean J. T. Sandefur and Mr. Reginald Laswell represented Dr. Michael Binder.


Dr. Haynes noted the distribution to the deans of the revised proposal from the Council on Higher Education regarding extended campus instruction. The first review of this proposal is scheduled for June 1.

There was an extended discussion of the part-time budget for 1989-90. The budgeted amount has been increased, but it will be less than actually expended last year. The issues of class size and Community College enrollments received particular attention. Further work on a "class size" report prepared by the Office of Institutional Research was proposed in order to correct errors. Dr. Petersen will work with the staff deans to get a corrected version produced through the Office of Institutional Research.

Dr. Sutton made a motion that for the Fall 1989 Semester a standard be established setting enrollment limits for Community College courses at 75% of enrollment limits in regular university courses. The motion was approved.

The meeting was adjourned at 12:15 p.m.
