RECYCLING DROP-OFF CENTER  
INTRODUCED: 03-03-92

- PURPOSE:** For the Associated Student Government to allot \$500 from the recycling budget to fund the construction of a 24-hour aluminum recycling drop-off center.
- WHEREAS:** This would reduce campus waste, solidify campus community support, and fulfill a long-term goal of Associated Student Government.
- WHEREAS:** Dr. Robert Schneider, professor of agricultural mechanics, will be primarily responsible for the construction of this bin;
- WHEREAS:** This bin would have the capacity of holding approximately 4,000 aluminum cans;
- WHEREAS:** It would be built in such a way that additional recycling bins could be attached for the future collection of additional recyclable material (i.e., glass, newspaper);
- WHEREAS:** The design of this receptacle is such that the theft of cans is rendered nearly impossible;
- WHEREAS:** The bin would be emptied of a weekly basis by Physical Plant workers; and
- WHEREAS:** The money generated by this collection center would be returned to ASG for recycling purposes.
- THEREFORE:** We, as representatives of the student body, do hereby agree to allocate \$500 to Dr. Robert Schneider for the construction of a permanent 24-hour aluminum recycling bin.
