COLLECTION NOTE

The collection contains chiefly photocopies of research materials that relate to the Green River and its tributaries, including the towns and counties which embrace the Green River Valley. This data was obtained by researching materials in WKU's Department of Library Special Collections, through interviews, field trips, and visits to the technical libraries at the Tennessee Valley Authority facilities in Knoxville, Tennessee, and at Norris Dam's experimental technical station located near Knoxville. The gathering of the material occurred in the fall of 1984, in August 1985, and in February 1986. The collection's arrangement is organized topically and further arranged by date and/or alphabetical order.

Following a request for further research in August 1986, the Helen Bartter Crocker Collection in Manuscripts was consulted. Boxes 6 and 7 contain photocopied materials from the collection. An additional request resulted in a visit being made on February 6 and 7, 1986, to Tennessee Valley Authority's facilities and technical libraries in Knoxville, Tennessee, and at Norris Dam's experimental technical station. These materials comprise Box 8.
