The Senate is not against the idea of comprehensive examinations, they just feel that that is the exclusive prerogative of the faculty to determine what kind of examinations are appropriate. President Meredith stated his intentions to have budget materials in the hands of the Board approximately two weeks prior to the meeting on June 12 and expressed his availability to meet individually with Board members to talk about various parts and address any concerns.

With no further business to come before the Board, motion to adjourn was made by Mr. Travis and seconded by Dr. Evans. The meeting adjourned at approximately 4:29 p.m.
