## BOB STEVENSON DAY SET FOR MAY 18 AT RUSSELLVILLE

Bowling Green, Ky. -- Former Westerner Bob Stevenson will have his day in Russellville May 18.

On that day Robert E. Stevenson, retiring superintendent of the Russellville City Schools, will be honored with a banquet at 7 p.m. (CDT) in the R.E. Stevenson Elementary School.

Stevenson, who holds both B.A. and M.A. degrees from Western, was principal of Adairville High School before joining the Russellville system in 1948. He has served as superintendent since 1950.

The former Western baseballer under the late E.A. Diddle has been active with the Southern Association of Secondary Schools and Colleges, serving as a board member and president.

Stevenson has continued his association with the University as a member of advisory committees to the College of Education and an active member of the "W" Club.

Stevenson's daughter, Mrs. Jane Broyles, holds B.S. and M.A. degrees from Western and currently is teaching at the University's Jones-Jaggers Laboratory School in Bowling Green.
