

Our primary purpose is to plan and present a variety of activities designed to serve the cultural, educational and social interests of all students enrolled at Western Kentucky University. Members of the University Center Board become involved in choosing programs sponsored on our campus and work to produce the events. Multiple opportunities exist for members to express creative thinking and exercise leadership skills!

Lecture Committee

The Lecture Committee brings to campus well-known, thought provoking speakers. These speakers discuss contemporary issues in their specialized fields. Concert Committee

Special Events Committee
