Whereas, a large number of Western Kentucky University students rent or lease housing in Bowling Green/Warren County, Ky., and,

Whereas, Bowling Green/Warren County Kentucky has experienced a problem with substandard housing arising in part from landlord neglect and in part from tenant neglect, and

Whereas, the majority of landlords and tenants are responsible individuals dedicated to the preservation of their property and,

Whereas, convincing legislation and strict enforcement is necessary to help alleviate the problem of substandard housing and clarify landlord/tenant rights and responsibility, and

Whereas, said legislation is to be offered at this term of the General Assembly as an extension of the Uniform Landlord Tenant Reform Act (ULTRA) which now applies to the Louisville and Lexington areas, and,
