Establishment of Minority Affairs Committee

PASSED UNANIMOUS - Feb. 13, 1979

Whereas, since Western Kentucky University admitted Rev. Joseph Jones as its first black student, there have been problems between individuals and groups, based more on a lack of understanding of the differences of each others' cultures than on anything else, and

Whereas, we, the members of the Associated Student Government of Western Kentucky University, should take a more active role in helping to bring an end to this problem by encouraging communication and cooperation,

Therefore, be it resolved, that the members of the Associated Student Government of Western Kentucky University support the idea of a Minority Affairs Committee of the Associated Student Government as outlined and hope this can be the beginning of an improved atmosphere of cooperation on the campus of Western Kentucky University.
