

Bill 78-
Resolution 5 Passed 10/10/78

- Whereas: The Academic Council Student Council is a hybrid group, an organization spanning two unique constituencies, not only being a part of Associated Student Government, but also subordinate to the office of Student Affairs and,
- Whereas: The selection of Academic Council members effect not only Congress but another separate and distinct organization and,
- Whereas: Academic Council members are more familiar with the needed qualifications and capabilities that an Academic Council representative should have in fulfilling his role as a member of the University Academic Council, a role distinct from the role of an Associated Student Government representative and,
- Whereas: To bring Associated Student Government's policy concerning the appointment of the Academic Council Student caucus more in line with the current policy of the University Academic Council which fills vacancies through a consensus of the effective department members,
- Therefore, be it resolved: That the President of Associated student Government, the Academic Council member of the college with the vacancy, along with the Academic Council caucus chairperson serve as a screening committee to issue the name of the individual of those who have applied for the position who they believe is the best qualified to fill the vacant Academic Council seat. This recommendation will then be brought before the Executive Council. The Executive Council can then pass this recommendation on to Congress for approval or in review of applications decide to recommend another applicant. Applications for Congress seats will be available during ASG office hours.
