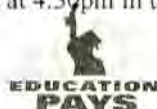

The bill could not be voted on last night because there were not enough members present.


New Business
