BIOGRAPHY

John D. Burt was born in 1955. He received his Bachelor's degree in 1977, Master's degree in 1978, and his Ph.D. in 1983 from Yale University. He was a teaching assistant while at Yale. In 1983 he accepted a faculty position in the English Department at Brandeis University, where his area of speciality was American literature. Doctor Burt wrote extensively about Robert Penn Warren and served as Warren's literary executor. Burt was also a poet.
