AMENDMENT

1.1 There shall be three (3) student representatives to the University Senate of Western Kentucky University, who shall be appointed by the President and confirmed by a 2/3 majority vote in Congress.

1.2 These three (3) student representatives shall:

- 1.2.1 Have completed 60 hours at Western upon accepting this appointed seat.
- 1.2.2 Be open to all full time students in good standing, with the University with and having a 2.75 GPA or higher.

- 1.2.3 Have no more than one representative from each academic college.
- 1.2.4 Attend all University Senate meetings.
- 1.2.5 Be required to report to Congress at the next official congressional meeting.

1.3 Any unexcused absences from the University Senate meetings and/or failure to report to Congress is grounds for review by Judicial Council, who shall retain power of removal.
