RESOLUTION 93-11-F MINORITY SCHOLARSHIPS

Introduced: November 9, 1993

PURPOSE: For Western Kentucky University to provide minority

scholarships available to ethnic minority students

other than African-Americans.

WHEREAS: Western provides scholarships specifically for

African-Americans, for which other ethnic minorities

can not apply, and

WHEREAS: Western is currently in accordance with the Council

on Higher Education in increasing the proportion of

African-American undergraduate students, and

WHEREAS: Providing more ethnic minority scholarships would

make Western more appealing to divers groups of

people. It would also add to the growth, prosperity,

and cultural advancements, of the students at

Western, and

WHEREAS: Western has agreed to increase funding for academic

scholarships to be given to African-American

students, and

WHEREAS: Western offers a \$600 College Heights Foundation

Scholarship to an African-American student, and

WHEREAS: Western also offers additional scholarships to

African-American students meeting certain ACT and

GPA or class percentile requirements, and

WHEREAS: African-Americans are not the only students

enrolled at Western that are considered to be a

minority, and

WHEREAS: Only one scholarship is currently available directly through Western Kentucky University to minorities other than African-Americans, and

WHEREAS: It should be the University's responsibility to provide equal opportunities to all ethnic minorities in proportion to their population, and

WHEREAS: This resolution is not to discredit African
Americans, detract from them in any manner, or take
away from scholarships available to African
Americans, but to enhance opportunities that do not
exist for other ethnic minorities at Western Kentucky
University.

THEREFORE: Be it resolved that we, the members of the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University, ask the University to offer at least four minority scholarships to be made available to ethnic minorities other than African-Americans with the requirements being the same as the scholarships offered to African-American students.
