***BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE***

Tandie Lewis McIntire was born 15 February 1865 in Kentucky. She was the daughter of T.B. and Angeline Winston Gardner McIntire. She became an active member of the Edmonson County teaching profession at the age of 17. During her lifetime she taught at several schools including Silent Grove, Brownsville School, and Brownsville High School in many areas of general education. She considered becoming one of the first high school teachers at Brownsville High School—heading the Ancient and Modern Language Department—a career highlight. She resigned from the high school in 1937 and worked as the secretary to Earl C. Reed, the Edmonson County School Superintendent, until her retirement in 1946. Later she was remembered for her educational contributions when the high school in Brownsville was named for her. Throughout her life she was dedicated to various charities, foreign Baptist church missions, and women’s groups by sending substantial donations within both the United States and China. She is remembered by many family members, friends, and acquaintances as a devoted Christian leader and teacher within the Brownsville Baptist Church.

McIntire died at the home of her cousin Lena Davis, of Houston, Texas on 1 March 1947. She was buried in Smiths Grove Cemetery, Warren County, Kentucky.

***COLLECTION NOTE***

The Tandie Lewis McIntire Collection consists of 3 boxes, 42 folders, and 456 items. It has two major focuses: school related materials which deal with McIntire’s academic career as a teacher and her active participation in religious activities, which included correspondence with Baptist ministers, foreign missionaries, charities, and women’s groups. Many of the items within the collection are photocopies of older items, yet the collection holds a great deal of original material which belonged to McIntire. Box 1 contains correspondence with family and friends, but also with many acquaintances whom she worked with in religious organizations. Of particular interest are the letters she received from Louise Tucker and B. S. Ding, who were Baptist

missionaries in China. Other materials included in Box 1 relate to education, such as school pamphlets and diplomas, and other miscellaneous items such as receipts, Christmas boxes, and newspaper clippings.

Box 2 contains the majority of the educational material that McIntire collected during her academic career. The folders in this box include her lesson plans, outlines, grade books, tests, class plays, and other miscellaneous items. Folder 8 of Box 2 contains notebooks given to McIntire by former students Carl B. Hill, Randall Hill, and Kellie White.

Box 3 consists of many religious tracts and materials McIntire collected throughout her life as a member of the Brownsville Baptist Church and Woman's Missionary Union. The folders in this box contain tracts which cover a wide array of topics ranging from foreign missions, to supporting missions for minority groups, to stewardship.
