#### BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Lillian Iona Tynes was born on 25 August 1925 in Russellville, Kentucky, the youngest of seven children of Oscar Franklin Tynes and Euva Hightower Tynes. She attended the public schools in Russellville, graduating from Russellville High School and later from Western Kentucky University.

Lillian married Dr. Robert N. Pace, a dentist, and they resided in Bowling Green, Kentucky. Mrs. Pace was active in a number of civic, religious, and philanthropic organizations. Her chief hobby was gardening, thus she was a member of the Ruth Rabold Garden Club as well as other state and national garden clubs. She served on the board of directors for Friends of Lost River, Mammoth Cave National Park Association, and the Friends of the Library. She served for nine years on Bowling Green Beautification Commission. Lillian also enjoyed handwork, reading, and singing.

Mrs. Pace died on 9 October 2010 and was interred in Bowling Green's Fairview Cemetery.

#### **COLLECTION NOTE**

This collection consists almost exclusively of materials collected during Lillian Iona Tynes's childhood and adolescence in Russellville, Kentucky. Of particular importance is her correspondence, 1932-1942, and three diaries, 1937-1940. A large portion of the collection relates to her attendance and work in the Russellville public schools, including report cards, school programs, certificates, tests, and news clippings. Box 2 contains a large amount of printed ephemera, including greeting and holiday cards, programs and realia removed from scrapbooks. The scrapbooks were disassembled because of condition.

Staples, paper clips and other metal fasteners have all been removed and replaced with vinyl coated paper clips. Small ephemera items have been placed in individual protective bags when necessary. All materials have been placed in acid folders and boxes.
