Letters to Sarah “Sally” Burgess, addressed to her in Davis (Scott County), Kentucky, Georgetown, Kentucky, and Newton, Illinois. Young men extend invitations, a niece writes of her social activities, and her sister Ella invites her to a “cantata” in Georgetown and describes her clothing needs. Another friend writes of social activities, including attendance at “negro minstrel” shows, for which she was “ashamed.”
