BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Joseph Dudley Downing was born on 15 November 1925 in Tompkinsville, Kentucky, to his parents Aldridge Clifton and Katie Burton Goodman Downing. He spent his childhood in Horse Cave, Kentucky, where he received his education and graduated valedictorian in 1943. After high school, Downing became an artillery observer in the army receiving a Bronze Star for his service in France during World War II. In 1945 Downing enrolled at Western Kentucky University, where art professor Ivan Wilson encouraged his artistic endeavors. However, respecting his parents' wishes, Downing pursued a degree in optometry by attending Northern Illinois College of Optometry in Chicago. He continued his art training by enrolling in classes at the Chicago Art Institute. Upon graduating in 1950, Downing decided to take a three-month trip to Paris, France, a place he had briefly seen during his military service. He fell in love with the city during his visit and became increasingly interested in pursuing art as a career. Downing decided to stay in Paris, and he continued to live in France for the remainder of his life.

Downing gave credit to the unique coloring and shapes of his abstract works to his childhood spent playing in the caves of his hometown and the ubiquitous barns found on the southcentral Kentucky landscape. The Kentucky countryside inspired Downing's works that were displayed museums and galleries around the world from the Louvre in Paris to the Kentucky Museum in Bowling Green. He was known for his unique use of color and the unusual material on which he painted which included old barn doors, stretched leather, chicken bones, and rescued provincial court documents. Throughout his career, Downing maintained his ties to Kentucky, keeping in close contact with his family and bringing his works back for galleries in his hometown and in local museums.

Downing passed away on 29 December 2007 in Menerbes, France, where he lived for 40 years. Memorial services and art showings were given in his honor in Kentucky and Meberbes. As was requested by Downing, his ashes were distributed in the two places he loved, Menerbes, France, and Horse Cave, Kentucky.

COLLECTION NOTE

This collection is made up of various forms of documentation about the life and work of Joseph Dudley Downing, chiefly created by his brother, Dero Goodman Downing. The first four boxes contain information concerning exhibitions of Downing's works both in the United States and abroad from 1952 to 2008. The documents include invitations, invitation lists, inventories, financial records, and some correspondence. Lists of artwork shown in exhibits and records of sales transactions made to patrons are also included in the boxes.

Boxes 5-7 contain publications about Downing and his art. Box 5 includes magazines in which Downing, or one his exhibits, were featured. Box 6 contains clippings from newspapers around the world about all aspects of Downing's artistic career from 1952 to his death. Box 7 includes articles and information from various artistic publications.

Boxes 8-12, contain correspondence between Dero Downing and patrons of Joe Downing's work. The subject of the letters chiefly concerns business affairs, including financial transactions and shipment of purchases. However, some of the correspondents are friendly and contain some personal matters. Patrons of Downing's range from local art galleries to art enthusiasts on Wall Street, all of whom maintained correspondence with Dero Downing.

Box 13 contains personal records and biographical information about Joe Downing from his birth in 1925, to his years in the military, to records of his memorial service in 2007. Biographies and accounts of his life are represented in this box in the form of dedications, articles, and photographs.

Box 14 has two tapes that narrate the work of Downing that aired on the radio in 1982 and on television in 1989.
