CIVIL War, 1861-1865 - Brownsville, SC 1861 Kentucky 3039

> Letter, 12 October 1861, to his father from an unidentified Confederate soldier in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Tennessee Cavalry Battalion. He describes his march from Bowling Green, Kentucky to Brownsville, Kentucky, and camp conditions. He also comments on Union sentiment there as distinct from abolitionism; describes an alarm raised in camp when one of the men was fired upon while watering his horse at Green River; and praises his captain for his treatment of the men and for discouraging any celebration when citizens were asked to take down the U.S. flag.
