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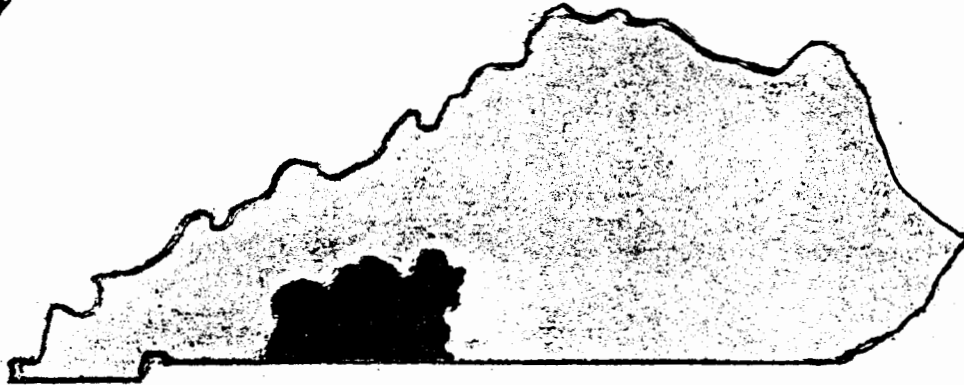

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE


Bear Club Members,

Need information on Hudnall, Milam, Morgan, Runner, Shields, Hines, Keown and Taylor. The Hudnalls were in Goochland, Bedford, and Buckingham counties in Va. (1700's); Warren Co. Tenn. (early 1800's) before coming to Bowling Green, KY. The Morgans were in Overton Co. Tenn. (late 1700's) and Cumberland Co., KY. (early 1800's) before coming to B.G. Ky. The Runners came from Pa. to Va. in the late 1700's, then Boyle Co. Ky. (early 1800's) then to B.G. The Shields were in Augusta, Nelson, and Amherst Counties in VA. (1700's and 1800's). The Keowns came from Flatwood or Charleston, S.C. (1700's) to Butler Co., KY. The Taylors were in Edgecomb Co., N.C. in 1801.
