Stanton

Water: Treatment capacity - 250 gpm; average daily use - 120,000 gallons; maximum daily use - 131,000 gallons; storage capacity - 255,000 gallons; size distribution lines - 10, 8, 6, and 4 inches

Sewerage: Treatment - primary and secondary; design capacity - 300,000 gallons per day or a population of 3,000; size of sewer mains - 12, 10, and 8 inches

Clay City

Water: Treatment capacity - 250 -gpm; average daily use - 70,000 gallons; maximum daily use - 130,000 gallons; storage capacity - 160,000 gallons; size distribution lines - 8 and 6 inches.

Sewerage: Treatment - primary and secondary; design capacity - 150,000 gallons per day or a population of 1,500; size of sewer mains - 8 and 6 inches; rates - \$4.99 minimum bill or 95% of monthly water bill
