Johnson County Water District:

Water: Purchases treated water from Paintsville Water Works; peak daily use - 40,000 gallons; size distribution lines - 8, 6, and 4 inches; storage capacity - 400,000 gallons

Rates:

3,000 gallons	\$6.75 (Minimum bill)
Next 3,000 gallons	1.25 per 1,000 gallons
All over 6,000 gallons	1.00 per 1,000 gallons

Sewerage: Type treatment - primary; design capacity - 750,000 gallons per day; size of sewer mains - 8 inches

Rates: 70 percent of monthly water bill
