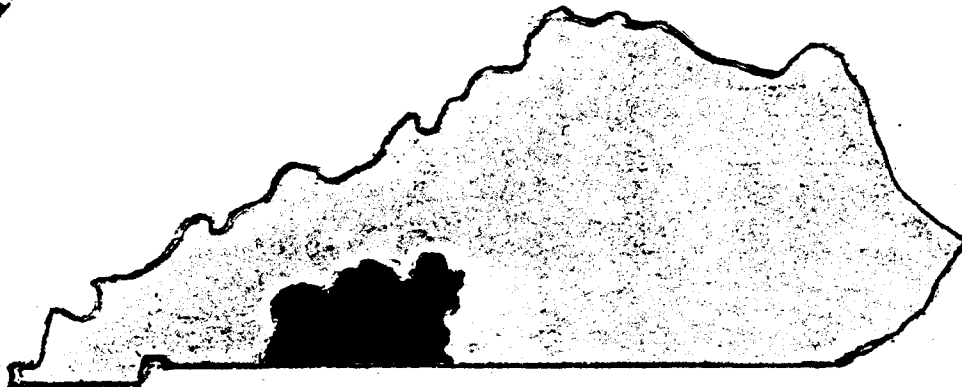

Mrs. Virginia Hope Posey DeVries is a resident of Warren County, Kentucky. She was born Jan.30, 1911 in Wichita, Kans., where she was reared and educated, the daughter of Henry Alvin Posey and Hattie Emma Donoho, both native-born Warren County Kentuckians. Her father was in the grocery and oil leasing business and active in Kansas Democratic politics. Her mother taught school. Virginia graduated from Wichita High School East as member of the Nat'l Honor Society, afterwards attending the Wichita Business University and the Wichita Comptometer School.

During the following 35 yrs. she pursued a career in government, occupying positions in all levels -- Federal, State, County and City, launching her career in 1931 by accepting employment in Wash.D.C: First, in income tax, Bur.of Int.Rev. and then as Legal Secy. at the Federal Trade Commission from 1935-38. She was among the first group of employees to occupy the new Fed.Trade Com.Bldg. where she witnessed at the dedication ceremony a list of the names and signatures of this group, including hers, being placed in the cornerstone of the building by Pres. Franklin Delano Roosevelt.

While living in Wash.D.C., Virginia attended the Inaugural Ceremonies of President Roosevelt in 1932. She frequently attended Congressional Sessions at the U.S.Capitol, and witnessed Ky's Alben W. Barkley presiding in the U.S.Senate. Alben is a cousin of hers through her great grandparents, the late Elleanor Frances Smith and Jackson Brown Posey of Bowling Green, Ky.

After 7½ years in Wash.D.C., she transferred in 1938 to the Fed.Trade Com.Chicago,Ill. where she also attended the Moody Bible Institute's Evening School; met Frederick George DeVries II, ministerial grad., and married Nov.30,1939 at the Moody Memorial Church, Chicago. She then also became involved in gospel work there with her husband.

Shortly after the birth of her daughter, Christine Hope, on Aug.21,1943, during World War II, Virginia's husband's civilian job with the US Army necessitated traveling, and she moved back to Wichita, Kans. until 1946 when he was sent to Ft.Campbell, Ky. She then rejoined him and they settled at Oak Grove, Ky. opposite Ft.Campbell, opening up a furniture business, Fred selling modern and Virginia, antiques. On Jan.19,1947, their son, Frederick George DeVries III, was born at the Bowling Green,Ky. Hospital.

In 1950, upon her husband tendering his resignation with the US Army to take charge of the business, Virginia resumed her Federal Career by accepting employment at Ft. Campbell: First, as Secy. to the Chief of Med. Service, US Army Hosp; then, in 1953 as Secy. to Deputy Post Commander; and finally, as Secy. to Brig Gen. Charles E. Chase, Offices of Commanding General where she was cleared for "Top Secret" during the Korean War period and received an "outstanding rating".

In 1955, the family moved to Bowling Green, Ky. and Virginia transferred to the Social Security Administration as Cla ims Stenographer, which position she occupied until her retirement in March, 1962, after 25 years Federal Service. She then received a medal and Service Certificate from the U.S.Civil Service Commission, Wash.D.C.

After retirement from the Federal Government (March, 1962), Virginia accepted employment (beginning the Fall, 1972 to 1970) as follows: City of Bowling Green, Ky. as payroll clerk; Warren County, Ky. in Welfare Center as social worker; and then with the State of Kentucky, Western Ky.Univ., as Secy.toDean of College of Commerce, where she worked over 5 yrs., while living on the family farm with her husband and son, who was also a student at Western Ky.Univ. at the time. Virginia's husband died June 18,1967 and she and her son continued on the farm, in addition to their other activities.

In 1970 she resigned her position at Western Ky.Univ. to become available to Kentucky State officials relative to the Green River Parkway being built through the DeVries Farm. Upon completion of the Pkwy. she became one of the first to collect tolls, being stationed as Toll Attendant at the Bowling Green Plaza where she witnessed the ribbon-cutting ceremony and official opening of the Parkway by Gov.Wendell Ford on Dec.15, 1972. Virginia retired in 1977 under the Ky. Mandatory Retirement Law for employees reaching age 65, after working 3½ years as Toll Attendant. This completed her government career in all levels during the 35 year period.

Since retirement from Kentucky State employment, she has actively participated in politics, campaigning for her favorite candidates. She is presently 1979 Secy. of the Warren County Demo. Women's Club and 1979-80 Secy-Treas. of Kentucky's Second Dist. Demo. Women's Clubs. She is a charter member of the So.Ky.Genealogical Society, of which she is Vice-Pres; is an active member of the Nat'l Assn. of Retired Federal Employees; member of Ky. Farm Bureau; Amer.Assn. of Retired Persons; and member of the Nat'l Assn. of Amer. Bus. Women. Virginia also taught Sunday School for years and is presently a member of the First Baptist Church of Bowling Green, Ky.

She has two grandchildren, born to her son Frederick George DeVries III and his wife Constance Jean Hughes as follows: Frederick George DeVries IV (nick-named "Erick") born Nov. 24, 1975, and Amy Christine DeVries, born Jan.19, 1978, both of whom were born in Nashville, Tenn. at the Baptist Hospital. They live in Bowling Green, Ky.

Virginia's daughter, Christine Hope, is married to David Sowders, a building contractor, and they have no children. Christine is a professional Clinical Social Worker, certified by the State of Ky. and is in business for herself, in Bowling Green, Ky.

Ancester hunting is the principal hobby of Virginia, and through the guidance and assistance of the So. Ky. Gen. Society's President, Mrs. Claire Davenport, she has been successful in tracing several ancestors back to the Colonial period and beyond.
