#### Water and Sewerage

Water: Daily treatment capacity - 400,000 gallons; average daily use - 170,000 gallons; maximum daily use - 250,000 gallons; storage capacity - 300,000 gallons; size distribution lines - 4, 6, and 8 inches. (Meade County Water District was organized July 15, 1971.)

Sewerage: Type treatment - clarifier, digester, and chlorination; design capacity - 300,000 gallons per day; size of sewer mains - 8, 12, and 18 inches.
