Water and Sewerage

Water: Daily treatment capacity - 1,500,000 gallons; average daily use -940,000 gallons; maximum daily use - 1,240,000 gallons; storage capacity -450,000 gallons; size distribution lines - 4, 6, and 8 inches.

<u>Sewerage</u>: Type treatment - digester, drying beds, trickling filter; design capacity - 1,250,000 gallons per day; size of sewer mains - 18 to 24 inches.
