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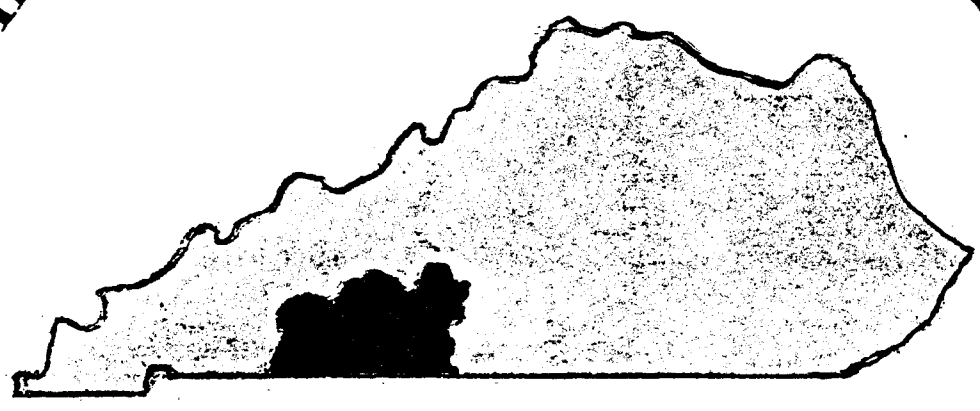

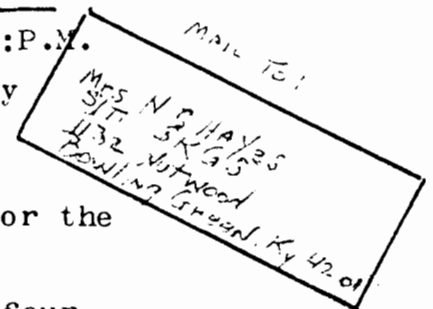
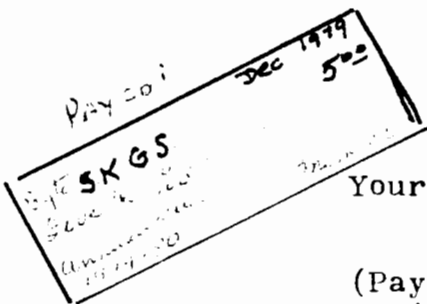

In the name of God, Amen. I, Prudy D. Smith, of sound mind and disposing memory, knowing the uncertainty of life and the certainty of death, do make this my last will and testament.

First, I desire that after my death my remains be decently buried in my family graveyard and my soul saved. I then bequeath to my son, Jonathan G. Smith, all of my estate, both real and personal, after paying my burying expenses, except the property hereinafter mentioned, viz:

To Martha A. Smith, wife of M. M. Smith, half of my dishes, a glass waine and preserves stands. I want Moses M. Smith to have one bed, six quilts and 2 pillers and my trunk. I give to my son, William Thomas, one lowinge and its bed and one quilt.

John J. Smith is to have my safe and half of my cooking vessels. William J. Smith is to have the other half.

I want Arty-missey Cotton, my daughter, to have my press. I want Elizabeth Epock to have 2 dollars.

I want Mary F. Edwards to have my bureau.

I want the balance of my estate, with all accounts and outstanding debts to vest in my son, Jonathan F. Smith, in order to compensate him for his care and support of me during my life. I want him to let out the property mentioned to my heirs and pay my debts.

ANNOUNCING PUBLICATION OF

KEITH KINFOLKS

A record of James Keith, Sr. descendants in America from 1719 to 1979

James Keith, Sr. was brought to America as an infant about 1719. Since the Keith Family of Scotland and England were active in attempts to return the Stuart Family to the Throne, evidence indicates possibly his parents were deported to the Colonies or were fleeing punishment for their part in the Jacobite Rebellion and the disasterous Battle of Sheriffmuir in 1715.

This book tells of the origin of the Keith family as a tribe in Germany where they were known as the Chatti and of their refusal to accept terms of their conqueror. They migrated to present day Holland where they were unwelcome because the natives considered them too industrious, thriving and warlike and ordered their departure. The Chatti set sail with their wives and children and were forced by storm to land in Scotland. The Scots, alarmed by a people trained in war, declined them a share of their country and ordered their departure. The newcomers refused and were victorious in the battle which followed. They increased, prospered, and spread from the Eleventh through the Seventeenth Centuries. Their surname comes from a royal grant to them of lands of Keith in East Lothia; Keith meaning wooded place. Because of their adherence to the Stuart Family cause in the Jacobite Rebellion and the climaxing Battle of Sheriffmuir in 1715 they lost their estates and Royal titles, were executed, imprisoned, deported and finished. KEITH KINFOLKS is a record of one group of these who were forced to immigrate to the American Colonies.
