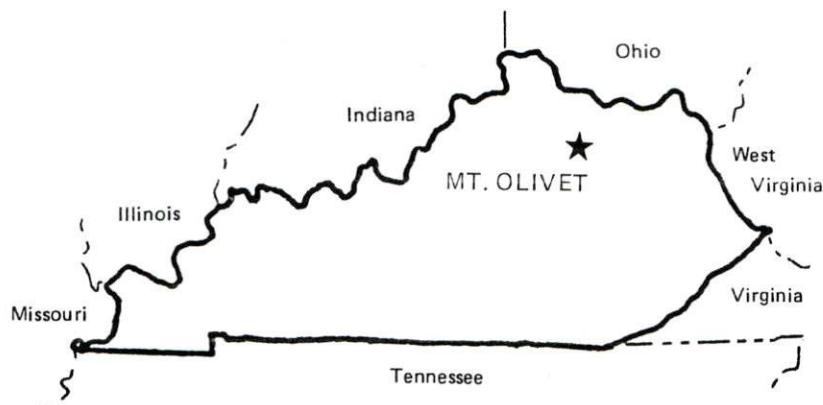

MAJOR LOCAL MANUFACTURING PLANTS:

Presently there are no manufacturing plants located in Mount Olivet.

TRANSPORTATION:

Rail: The nearest rail service is offered by The Chessie System at Maysville and provides 3 eastbound and 3 westbound freights daily. The Louisville and Nashville Railroad, also at Maysville, provides 1 eastbound and 1 westbound freight daily.

Highways: U.S. Highway 62 and Kentucky Highway 165 serve Mount Olivet. An interchange of I-75 is located 43 miles southwest of Mount Olivet.

Truck: Budig Western Trucking Company serves Mount Olivet with interstate and intrastate service.

Water: The nearest navigable river is the Ohio River, 23 miles away. The nearest public port is located northwest of Mount Olivet in the Northern Kentucky area.

Air: The nearest commercial airport, Blue Grass Field at Lexington, 52 miles away, is served by Delta, Eastern, Piedmont, Allegheny and Air Kentucky (Commuter) Airlines.

UTILITIES:

Electricity: Mount Olivet and portions of Robertson County are served by Kentucky Utilities Company. Robertson County is also served by Fleming-Mason RECC.

Natural Gas: The Mount Olivet Natural Gas Company, Inc., supplied by Columbia Gas Transmission Corporation, serves Mount Olivet.

Other Fuels: Supplies of propane and distillate fuel oil are provided by seven companies located in the area.

WATER AND SEWERAGE:

Water: The City of Mount Olivet Water Department serves Mount Olivet. The source of supply is the Licking River. The treatment plant capacity is 192,000 gallons per day. Peak daily use is 155,000 gallons.

Sewerage: Septic tanks are utilized at this time for sewage disposal.

GOVERNMENT STRUCTURE:

City: Mayor - 4-year term; 6 councilmen - 2-year terms

County: County Judge - 4-year term; 5 magistrates - 4-year terms

Telephone Company: Continental Telephone Company of Kentucky provides standard service to Mount Olivet.

Telegraph Service: Telegraph service is available at Maysville, 23 miles away.

Newspaper: The Robertson County Review is published weekly and has a circulation of 750. Papers from Brooksville, Maysville, Lexington, and Louisville, Kentucky, and Cincinnati, Ohio, are received.

OTHER LOCAL FACILITIES:

Hospitals: The nearest hospital is at Maysville, 23 miles away.

Churches: There are four churches in Mount Olivet. Denominations are Baptist, Christian, Christian Baptist and Methodist.

Financial Institutions: The Farmers and Traders Bank of Mount Olivet serves the area.
