Cost to any future water customer with usage of 1,500,000 gallons per month will be negotiated.

Livingston Municipal Water Works - Daily treatment capacity - 72,000 gallons; average daily use - 20,500 gallons; maximum daily use - 24,000 gallons; storage capacity - 72,000 gallons; size distribution lines - 3 and 6 inches

Brodhead - Construction has begun on the Brodhead Municipal Water Works. The water works will purchase water from the Mt. Vernon Water and Sewer Works.

The North Rockcastle County Water District is now being formed. Plans call for purchasing treated water from the City of Mt. Vernon. The water district will serve an area from Renfro Valley to the Rockcastle-Madison County line along U.S. 25.

Sewerage: Mt. Vernon Water Works - Type treatment - aeration; design capacity - 10,000 gallons per day or a population of 1,000; size of sewer mains - 6 and 8 inches. Sewer rates 75 percent of monthly water bill.

Brodhead - Construction has begun on a sewage treatment plant for the city.

Livingston - Municipal; Disposal - one 500-gallon and one 15,000-gallon city-operated concrete septic tank; size of sewer mains - 6, 8, and 10 inches.

Local Government

Mt. Vernon: Business license - \$5 to \$50 annually
Brodhead: Unloading license - \$12.50 annually or \$5 per day; privilege
license - based on size of business; car sticker - \$5 annually

Industrial Sites

The 25-acre site at Livingston, shown as Site #10 on the 1970 Rockcastle County industrial site map, is owned by the Louisville & Nashville Railroad. This site is presently being leased to a coal company, but is still available as a possible industrial site. All other sites shown on the 1970 map remain available for industrial use.
