LANDMARK ASSOCIATION REVIEW BOARD

Rehabilitation of the Stark Building, owned by J.C. Holland and Company at 927 College Street was reviewed by the Landmark Association Review Board on January 11, 1982. This CPA firm will occupy the first floor and basement with second and third floors left for future expansion and development.

The purpose of the newly organized Board is to review proposed downtown projects that would come under financing by the Citizens National Bank Historic Preservation Program. 
