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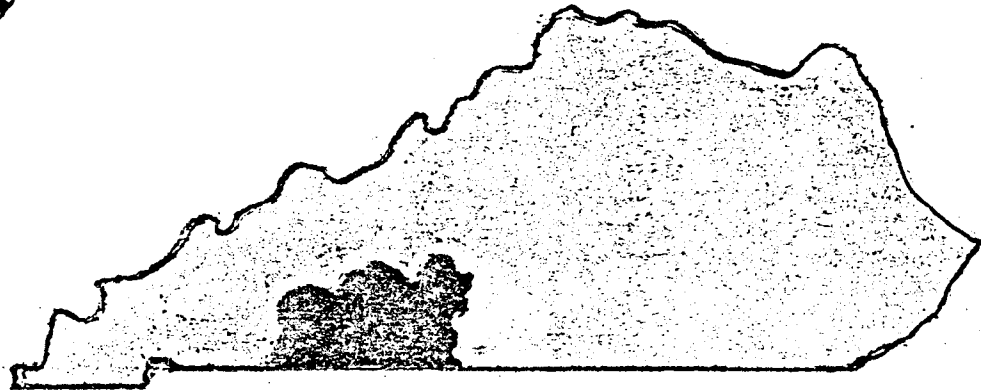

(This cemetery is in Butler County, near Green River and Little Ready Creek- just off the Region Road in the woods).

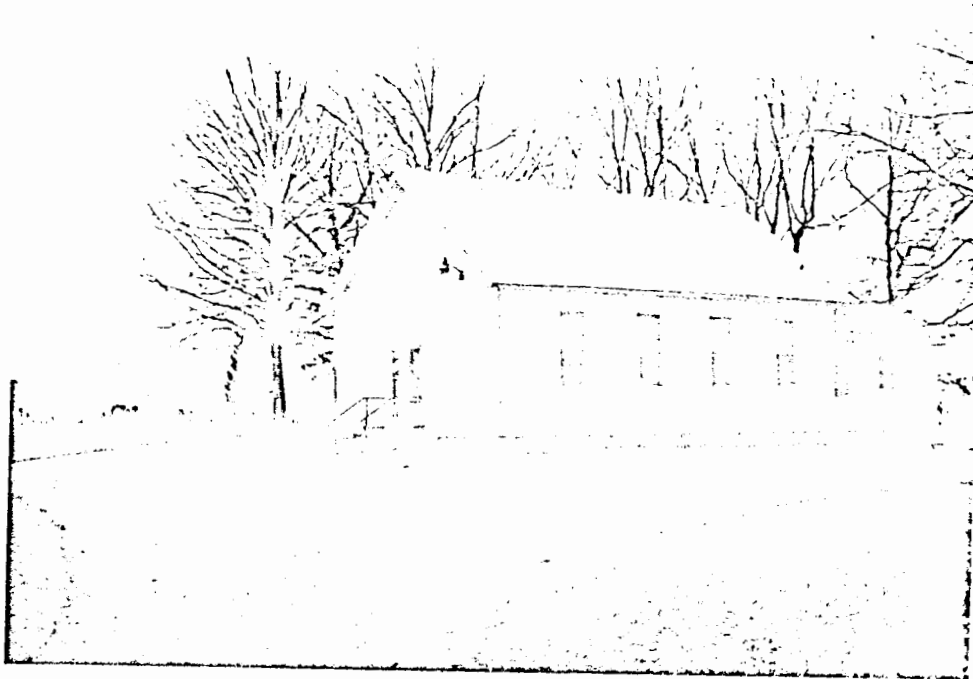

The church was first built on the Ridge road and called Cole's Chapel. The church was by the Cole Cemetery on the property now owned by Joe W. Willis. Five Cole monuments are there now. Two of the monuments are parents of Judith Cole Hudnall.

The Cole's Chapel Church had post in the middle of the church. The seats still used in church have cut-out places where they fit around the post. Seats were divided down the middle of church by a pole. Seats now used have small holes that the pole fit through. There were two doors in the church since men and women sit on different sides of the church.

When the church was moved to the hill where it still stands, it was named Mt. Pisgah. The posts and poles were removed, but otherwise the same building. The cemetery was started before the church was moved. John W. Hudnall was the first person buried in the cemetery.

The land for the cemetery and church was donated by John Sharrer father-in-law of Lucy Wayne (Hudnall) Sharrer: also known as Aunt Duck The church was moved in 1884, but the property was not deeded to the church until several years later by Carl Goodall. The deed is recorded in the Warren County Courthouse Book 210 Page 477.

The church now has double door in the front, and Sunday school rooms have been added on the back. The exterior has been covered with aluminum siding. The floors have also been carpeted.
